Entered service July 24, 1918 in Sturgeon Bay. Was with 27th Field Artillery, Battery B.

He was discharged February 6, 1919.

He was the last surviving veteran of World War I, according to Overly. His parents were Andrew Anderson and Nicoline Reimert.

Had a big farm on Swenson Road. Married Ruth Erickson 10/6/1935 and they lived on that farm their remaining years. Ruth's sister was a missionary in China. Lawrence and Ruth were very involved in Bethel Church. They had a son Robert. Robert Cornell bought that farm recently.

He was willing to donate his barn to the Farm Museum and \$25,000 to move it but the Farm Museum couldn't raise sufficient funds to complete the job and so had to reject the offer.
