Dave entered the Navy at Great Lakes, IL in March, 1981 where he took Boot Camp and then continued there for 'A' School, a second training period of two months. He was then assigned to an oiler, AOE-2, the *USS Camden* in Bremerton, Washington where he spent three years. Following that he was returned to Great Lake for three years as an instructor in the "Hot Plant", simulating the engine room of a ship. Then to the *USS ST Louis, LKA 116*, a supply ship stationed in Sasebo, Japan. He was then assigned to the aircraft carrier *USS Constitution* spending 6 months in the Philadelphia shipyard before going around Cape Horn to San Diego for another tour of duty. Then back to Great Lakes for another tour as an instructor, following which he was assigned to the carrier *USS Abraham Lincoln* out of Everett, Washington. Also, he was machinist mate. His final tour was at the Trident Training Facility in Bangor, Washington where he retired.
