

Volney Spaulding Garrett

Drafted in the last draft of the Civil War on 3/30/1865 but may not have served as the war ended two weeks later.

He came to Illinois in 1848, and then to Washington Island on April 15, 1853. He was the son of Milton Garrett, and Lanie (?) who lived in Joliet, IL. He married Rebecca M. Lee on April 16, 1855. "There was born unto them five children: Harriet Esther, 2/15/1856; Junius Volney, 3/15/1859; Alice Rebecca, 3/17/1862; Adeline, 12/29/1864; William Milton S. Garrett, 4/30/1870." All born on the Island, except Junius who was born in Joliet.

He attended the Republican convention in 1890 in Door County.

According DCA item of April 4, 1869, he was elected town supervisor.

Jack Hagen was a descendant, as is Joy Gunnlaugsson.
