Served in France. Spent a summer on the Lakes before service. He was drafted among 1000 men from Wisconsin, in June 1918, and among 16 sent to Laurel, MD.

After service, he farmed and never married. Had a brother, Vernie. His parents were the Marcus Petersens.

Later in life he was sick for many years, and died from uremic poisoning.
