Served from May 31, 1918 to 7/18/1919 overseas in France.

He was one of the twenty charter members of American Legion Post 402 and was vice Commander in 1940.

He sent a book of postcards with pictures showing various scenes from the battle of Chateau-Thierry, the first American victory of World War Two. It's in the file box B10 F2a.

He was a commercial fisherman after service. His wife was Trina, who sewed for the Islanders. He was not part of the Arni Richter family. (JG)

His parents were Fred Siegel Richter (8/14/1862- 11/23/1925) and Ida Cornell (8/27/1867- 214/1928) who were married on October 26, 1886.

He married Katheryn (Trina) Erickson on July 3, 1920.
