Enlisted Navy 6/6/1917, and shipped to Norfolk, transferring to Hampton Roads in October for six months, and then to *USS Minnesota*. He was assigned to 12" gun as Hoistman. He was discharged 8/1919.

His ship was torpedoed on 9/29/1918. He made three trips to France and carried troops back to US.

He was second commander of American Legion Post 402, and one of the twenty charter members of the post. Prior to helping found Post 402, he was in the American Legion in St Louis, and later in Sturgeon Bay.

He retired to the Island in 1965. He once tried to start a bakery in the home now owned by Jerry Rupiper, but it didn't work because he would rather go fishing.

He married Ruth Saabye on 10/15/1921. They had four children, two girls, Clementine and Margory, and two boys, Bruce and Cliff. (JG) He had four brothers and one sister.

Married Andrea Anderson on August 21, 1943.
